<b>Chardonnay-Marsanne, Sandpiper (France)</b> Herbaceous nose & citrus crispness capturing the floral fruit character of the grapes. Contains some crystallisation – 13%	£14.95

<b>Gruener Veltliner, Loimer, Kamptal (Austria)</b> A stunning wine with charming grace – complex, generous fruit with a clean mineral streak – Austria’s national grape first planted in 1203 – 12%	£20.95
<b>Sauvignon Blanc, Chocalan, Casablanca Valley (Chile)</b> An excellent Sauvignon - intense & persistent aromatic perfume reminiscent of sage & elder – 12.5%	£16.95
<b>Gavi di Gavi DOCG, Ca’Dameo, Gavi (Italy)</b> A fine example of the indigenous Cortese grape – crisp, fruity with a good length – 12.5%	£17.95
<b>Sauvignon Blanc, Marlborough (New Zealand)</b> Zesty & crisp, it zings & sings with life – 13%	£19.75

<b>Viognier Reserva, Tabali, Limari Valley (Chile)</b> Wonderful aromatic & floral notes with a fruit-driven palate & gentle acidity – 13.5 %	£19.75

<b>Zinfandel, Winston Hill, California (USA)</b> Soft & easy-drinking with sweet berry fruits and a twist of spice. Stunning value – 14.5%	£15.25
<b>Pinot Noir Reserva, Nostros, Casablanca Valley (Chile)</b> Ripe red berry fruits dominate. Full, elegant and smooth with a long finish – 14.5%	£16.95
<b>Malbec, Pascual Toso, Mendoza (Argentina)</b> Rustic and full-flavoured with hints of coffee, violet and blackberry and just a touch of vanilla – 14%	£19.50

<b>Fleurie, La Chapelle des Bois, Beaujolais (France)</b> Medium-bodied with ripe, raspberry & cherry flavours & a long, lingering finish – 13%	£26.50
<b>Pinot Noir, Marlborough (New Zealand)</b> Fresh & precise, intensely flavoured with a smooth, subtle texture – 13%	£22.50
<b>St. Julien, La Reserve de Leoville Barton, Bordeaux (France)</b> 15 months ageing in oak barrels. The subsequent wine is concentrated but elegant, with ripe fruits & delicate perfume – a claret of true class – 13%	£51.50

<b>Gutturnio Classico, Torretta (Italy)</b> This exceptional wine produces a rich, fresh bouquet which explodes onto the palate - pure class – 13%	£18.95
<b>Merlot, Soldier’s Block, Mount Benson (Australia)</b> Dense, powerful mulberry & blackberry fruit with gentle oak and hints of mocha on the palate with a soft, rich finish – classy stuff - 14.5%	£15.95
<b>Amarone della Valpolicella, DOC, San Michele (Italy)</b> An inimitable wine, thanks to the myriad olfactory sensations & the rich, persistent flavour – 15%	£36.95
<b>Gevrey-Chambertin, Domaine Chevalier (France)</b> This wine shows attractive maturity with good structure and length. A stunning Burgundy – 13%	£49.50
